At the top, the header as seen in this document has to be placed.

All the body text should be

- Times New Roman 11pt
- Paragraphs justified
- One empty line between paragraphs
- One empty line between paragraph and next header or sub-header

All headers should be

- Times New Roman **bold** 11pt
- One empty line before and after each header
- Without numbering
- If you want to use sub-headers use
 - Times New Roman *italic* 11pt
 - No empty line after sub-header
 - Without numbering

- One empty line between figure caption and the next paragraph or header

Your figure can be placed in two ways, as a centered in-line object with the figure caption below (for big wide figures 16 cm max in 170 dpi), or in a two-column table (7.5 cm max in 170 dpi) (no table borders) with the figure caption to the right. This looks like the two figures below.

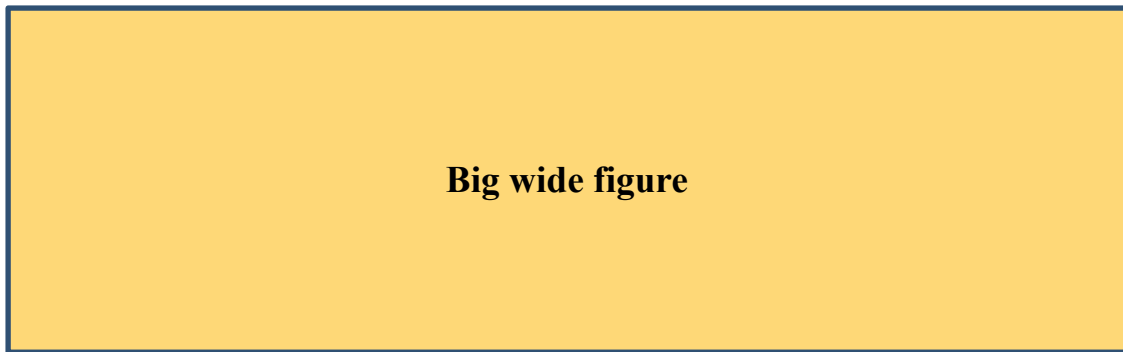


Figure 1: Big figure as a centered in-line object. If the caption is shorter than one line of text, use centered paragraph style, otherwise use justified.
